Helicopter Report October

Narrative:

This month we have made a fantastic break-through on the funding for the helicopter operations! Ms. Sue Anschutz-Rodgers pledged 35,000USD for fuel and maintenance of the helicopter. Sue's donation is the single largest donation and equates to 117 hours of flying time. Thank you very much Sue, from myself, the MEP team, and the elephants in the Mara!

This month was the first time we completed a full recce of all the collared elephants in the Mara Ecosystem. We managed to view and photograph 14 of the 17 collared elephants spanning an area of 11,500km². The flight took 5.2 hours to complete with 2 refueling stops at KWS and the MEP headquarters. Using the Save the Elephants aerial monitoring form we managed to gather important data on herd sizes and structures, proximity to people, water and livestock, check VHF beacons, and general condition of the herds. We did not get a visual of elephant "Lucy" because

she was in thick forest. We were also unable to visit 2 collared elephants in Tanzania. We will continue to furnish these flights once per month.

One notable operation was when an elephant herd went into farms and was attacked by farmers. We managed to mobilize the KWS Vet though the DSWT Sky Vet program to treat the wounded elephants. The worst hit elephant had 11 arrowheads stuck in her skin all over her body. Dr. Limo and team managed to pull/cut them all out. We also deployed a collar on her. This will enable us to monitor recovery and get valuable data from a crop-raiding elephant.
